ABC Weekend Sting in Dodge City Nets Arrests for Illegal Alcohol Sales, Child Endangerment

Jan. 14, 2014

TOPEKA – Alcoholic Beverage Control agents, in conjunction with the Dodge City Police Department, arrested four women and two men for illegally selling alcohol during a sting Sunday.

After a month long investigation, agents and police officers simultaneously served warrants at four Dodge City houses and seized 1,227 bottles and cans of liquor and beer, four chest freezers and \$2,711.

In addition to multiple counts of furnishing alcohol to a minor, evasion of liquor tax and selling alcohol without a license, Roberto Rodriguez-Jurado, 46, and Maria Rodriguez-Hernandez, 38, were charged with aggravated endangerment of a child and contributing to a child's misconduct.
