Greenwood County storm victims can get free document, credential replacement

TOPEKA—Residents of Greenwood County, Kan. affected by Tuesday’s tornado can get free replacement car titles, registration receipts, and drivers licenses if those documents were lost or damaged in the storm, Kansas Division of Vehicles director David Harper announced Wednesday.

Applications for replacement titles and replacement registration receipts can be made at the Greenwood County Treasurer’s office, 311 N. Main Street Suite 4 Eureka, Kan.

Greenwood County residents in need of a replacement driver’s license or ID can go to [any driver’s license office in the state](#) with proof of Greenwood County residency and receive a free replacement credential.

“Official documents are vital for the process of rebuilding after a natural disaster,” Director Harper said. “The Division of Vehicles is happy to assist Eureka and Greenwood County residents in obtaining free replacements.”
