## Mission driver's license office now offers Driver Solutions services

**TOPEKA**—The Mission, Kan. driver's license office now provides Driver Solutions services, including credential reinstatement, motor vehicle reports, and applications for restricted driving privileges, among others.

Drivers can visit the office at 6507 Johnson Drive Mission, Kan, or call (913) 432-2266 with questions.

The full list of Driver Solutions services include:

- Driver's license reinstatements customers can bring in documents needed to reinstate their suspended driver's license. Suspensions could be for unpaid tickets, alcohol, insurance violations, etc.
- Taking applications for restricted driving privileges if customer is suspended for alcohol or unpaid tickets, they may apply for restricted driving privileges.
- Taking reinstatement fees in the form of cash, check, or money order
- Providing motor vehicle reports

Driver Solutions services at the Mission office are available Tuesday and Wednesday – 9:00-3:45 and Thursday and Friday – 8:00-4:45.

Drivers visiting the Mission driver's license office seeking standard service for credential renewal or first-time issuance, can use Q-Flow, which allows drivers to hold their place in line. That service can be accessed via phone or on the web at http://getinline.kdor.ks.gov/WebAppt/WizardTicket/Services.
