

LEAVING THE SCENE OF AN ACCIDENT

Driver Control will record on the Kansas driving record violations that cite K.S.A. 8-1602 (HR1), 8-1603 (HR2) or 8-1604 (HR2).

A conviction under K.S.A. 8-1602 (HR1) requires a 90-day mandatory revocation unless the court orders a suspension or restriction. Following the revocation, suspension, or restriction action, an SR22 must be filed with Driver Control. Driver Control will notify the driver to file the SR22.

A conviction under K.S.A. 8-1603 or 8-1604 requires no action against the driving privileges and is only recorded on the driving record.

Driver Control will not record violations that cite K.S.A. 8-1605, 8-1606 or 8-1607.

Out-of-state convictions for leaving the scene of an injury accident are recorded on the driving record and action is taken as if the violation occurred in Kansas (i.e., 90-day revocation).

Out of state convictions for leaving the scene of a non injury accident are recorded on the driving record however, no action is taken against the driving privileges

Driver Control will not record violations that cite K.S.A. 8-1605, 8-1606 or 8-1607 on the Kansas driving record.
