## **INSTRUCTIONS**

- 1. Application for an Ex-Prisoner of War license plate must be made at the County Treasurer's Motor Vehicle Office. There is no registration fee for one Ex-Prisoner of War license plate on the vehicle of applicant's choice.
- 2. To qualify for an Ex-Prisoner of War plate, the applicant must be a Kansas resident and submit proof of status as an ex-prisoner of war (DD214), or be the surviving spouse of a former prisoner of war as determined by marriage license or POW DD214.
- 3. This application must be signed by the ex-prisoner of war or surviving spouse as a vehicle owner/lessee.
- 4. The current registration license plate (if applicable) must be exchanged for the Ex-Prisoner of War registration plate at the County Treasurer's Motor Vehicle Office.
