1. Submits satisfactory proof to the director of vehicles that such person is a recipient of the Army of occupation medal or the Navy occupation service medal. Proof shall be a DD214 or an official certificate issued by their branch of service that has information sufficient to show the individual is qualified.
2. The applicant must be a Kansas resident and submit proof of status (DD214)
3. This application must be signed by the qualified applicant as a vehicle owner/lessee.
4. The current registration license plate (if applicable) must be surrendered when the new plate is issued.
